Call for NL Municipalities

Our Creative Home Mural & Artist Residency Program

Deadline to submit: May 29, 2024

Do you want to highlight an artist and celebrate the Year of the Arts in your community?

Our Creative Home is an initiative offered by Municipalities NL and Business and Arts NL, and funded by the Government of Newfoundland's Department of Municipal and Provincial Affairs, to help municipalities across the province create an artist-in-residence program or commission a mural. The program will fund projects in 12 municipalities across the province.

This program offers funding and expertise to help municipalities design and implement a custom program that will reflect their community, engage the public, and demonstrate the vibrancy of our province's rich artistic heritage.

Our towns and cities are the home of our art and our culture. In the Year of the Arts, municipalities across the province are being encouraged to think artfully, and to apply to the Our Creative Home program, which offers grants of up to \$10,000 for mural and artist residency programs.

Please note this call is for Municipalities. Forward it on to your local representative and encourage them to apply.

Creativity and Innovation Conference

Business and Arts NL is hosting a creativity and innovation summit at the Sheraton Hotel on November 7, 2024, that will bring together 250 participants from across the business and arts communities to explore creativity: what it is, how to harness it, and how to apply it to fuel innovation.

We are seeking artists to create work to be presented as part of this event, including works that can be performed live, or works that are created in advance and displayed at the event. We welcome submissions from artists at all career

Our mission to facilitate meaningful dialogue and purposeful partnerships between the arts and business communities is front and center in the planning of this event. It follows that the involvement and work of artists is an essential element. It is deeply important that artist involvement is not "icing" or merely surface level. By integrating art and performance throughout the summit, we will demonstrate the vital role of art and creativity to inspire, challenge, and connect people, and how businesses can work with artists to create exceptional experiences. For this reason, **submissions of works with an interactive component are encouraged.**

Artist fees: \$3,500 - \$10,000

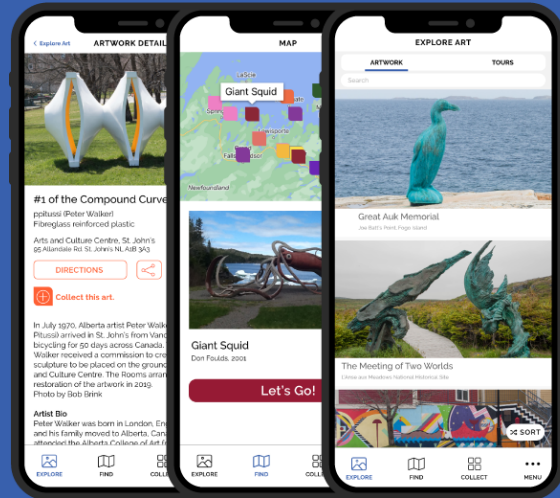

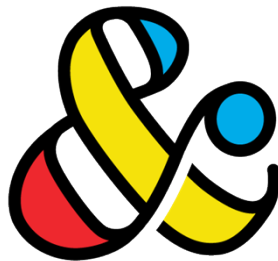

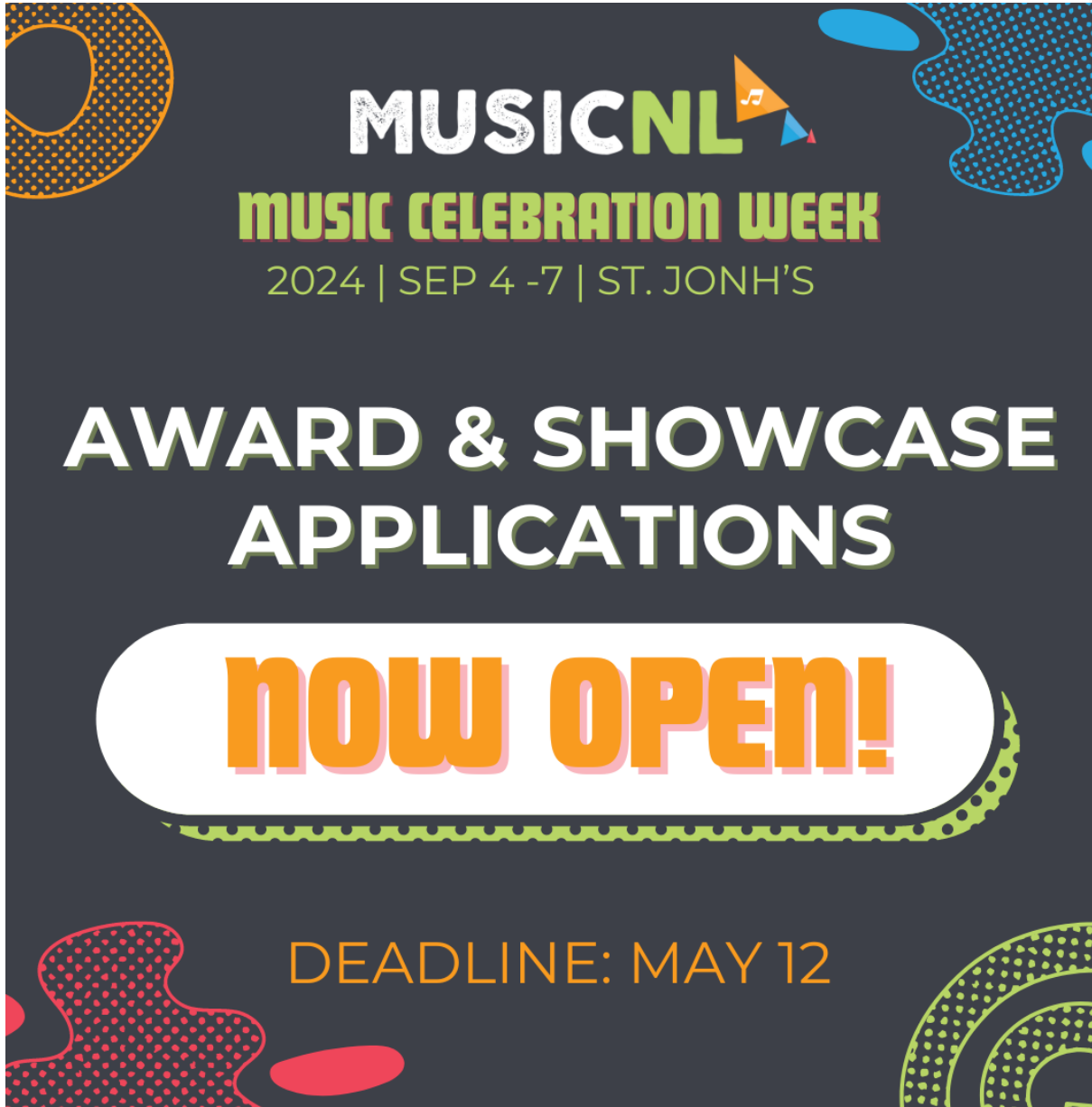

The Hnatyshyn Foundation – Joysanne Sidimus Ballet Grant of \$10,000 will support an exceptionally talented young dancer by bridging the gap between their full-time training and professional practice.

This \$10,000 grant is designed to help the most promising young Canadian ballet dancers. Dancers entering the final or penultimate year of a full-time, multi-year recognized post-secondary educational program, or entering a full-time educational, training, or apprenticeship program of one year or less at a recognized ballet company, are eligible. Students and apprentices are eligible.

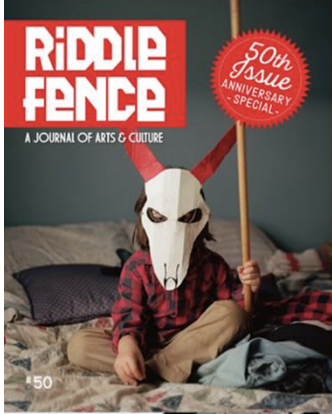
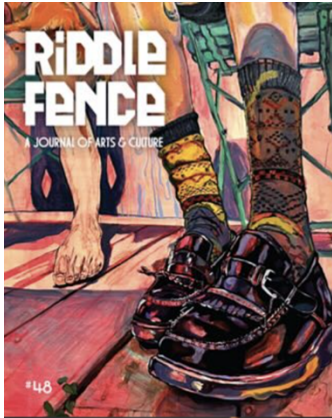

Artistic Fraud is pleased to announce that we are now accepting applications for the 2024 Dr. Lanier Phillips Memorial Scholarship.

The Dr. Lanier Phillips Scholarship is awarded annually to a BIPOC student entering post-secondary studies in the performing arts (theatre, dance, music,

opera) who is either from Newfoundland and Labrador or planning to study in Newfoundland and Labrador.

The scholarship is named for Dr. Lanier Phillips. Shipwrecked aboard the USS Truxtun in 1942, Dr. Phillips was the only African-American survivor. What happened to this son of the racially segregated south at the hand of the nearby town of St. Lawrence forever changed his world and became a legendary story that still resonates over seventy years later. Dr. Phillips was the subject of our play Oil and Water, and we are delighted to honour his legacy with this award.

Award: \$1000 awarded annually.

So many people are trying to be mindful of their environmental impact and doing what they can these days to reduce their carbon footprint, and that goes for

artists and arts organizations as well.

Touring shows, putting off festivals, running a busy office - it all makes an impact. But how much? And how do you measure that impact so that you can work in the most environmentally efficient way possible?

Enter Creative Green (CG) Tools. Created in 2009 by Julie's Bicycle, a UK non-profit that's dedicated to promoting sustainable practices in the arts, the CG Tools are now used by over 5,000 organizations in 50 countries worldwide. They're a free set of carbon calculation and reporting tools that lets arts and culture organizations across disciplines record, measure and understand the impacts of their venues, offices, tours, productions and more.

We're thrilled to have Devon Hardy, the Creative Green Tools Canada Program Director with the Centre for Sustainable Practice in the Arts, lead a free online information session for us on May 8, so that those working in the local arts and culture sector can learn more about how to implement these tools.
